

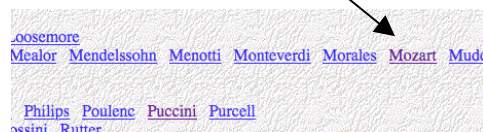
John Hooper's midi files

Click on <http://www.learnchoralmusic.co.uk> to enter John's website

For a major work click on "Choral Music"



... select the composer, e.g. "Mozart"



... and then select the work, e.g. "Vesperae solennes de confessore"

All the chorus movements of the music are listed with the option of choosing your voice part (i.e an emphasized line).
